Rattling Brook Cottages

are located in a secluded area behind the Powerhouse overlooking Norris Arm South and consist of a two apartment house and a cabin available for rental at a modest cost to Newfoundland Power retirees and employees and to Fortis employees.

Rental Information

Generally, from May 1 to October 31 the Rattling Brook Units are rented on a weekly basis (check-in/check-out time is Friday noon) and from November 1 to April 30 on a daily basis (check-in/check-out time is noon). All rentals must be paid before occupancy.

Rates

May 1 to October 31: for Trailblazers' members \$120 weekly for each of the three units, for non-members \$150 weekly.

Off season: \$30 daily to a maximum of \$120 per week for Trailblazers' members and to a maximum of \$150 per week for non-members.

General Information

On your arrival you should expect to find the unit in a clean and tidy condition with floors swept, garbage removed, empty bottles disposed etc.

Provided are:

- ◆ Fridge, range, microwave, toaster, pots, pans, dishes, glasses, cutlery, etc.
- ◆ Hot and cold water, bath or shower.
- ◆ Beds with mattresses.
- ◆ Color TV with satellite dish
- ◆ Kitchen table and chairs.
- ◆ Living room furniture.

What You Need to Bring:

- ◆ Bed sheets, pillows & blankets or sleeping bags.
- ◆ Food including coffee, tea, sugar, etc.
- ◆ Soap, bath towels, bathroom tissue, etc.
- ◆ Your own satellite dish receiver



Things You Need to Know During your Stay:

- ◆ Units are served by septic system so please use discretion with kitchen waste (grease and fats). Do not use any anti-bacterial soaps or detergents.
- ◆ Garbage is not collected. Please bag it, place it in the garbage container on grounds, secure it with the cover and take it with you

when you leave.

- ◆ Small contributions of dishes, cutlery, glasses etc. are welcome.
- ◆ Help us keep rentals as low as possible by mowing the lawn when necessary, and by replacing blown light bulbs.

When You Leave:

For courtesy and for the enjoyment of the next user:

- ◆ Clean all areas of the unit, particularly washroom and kitchen.
- ◆ Ensure grounds are tidy.
- ◆ Fill ice trays.
- ◆ Replace bathroom tissue and paper towels.
- ◆ Set all thermostats to 15C.
- ◆ Set built-in thermostats on "3".
- ◆ Ensure all lights are turned off.
- ◆ Ensure all exterior entrance doors and all windows are closed and locked.
- ◆ Take empty recyclables with you i.e. bottles, cans, carton containers etc.
- ◆ Take all garbage with you.
- ◆ **VERY IMPORTANT:** Return keys to the security box at the entrance gate.

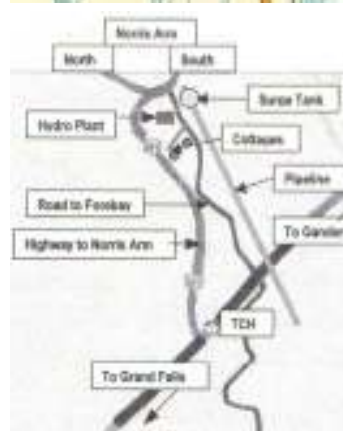
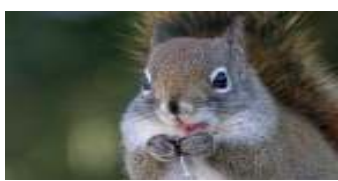
